The 19th International Cave Bear Symposium will be held in Semriach/Styria, a village located 25 km north of Graz, on a high plateau of the Grazer Bergland. The Grazer Bergland is a carstic region, well-known for caves with the most important archaeological and palaeontological findings in Austria. The "Drachenhöhle bei Mixnitz" is the largest bear cave in the Austrian Alps and became famous by the publication "Die Drachenhöhle von Mixnitz " (Abel & G. Kyrle, 1931). In Repolust cave fossil remains of cave bears, wolves and cave lions are mixed with

the oldest paleolithic artefacts in Austria. There are also many other bear caves (Badlhöhle, Kugelsteinhöhle, Lurgrotte, Peggauer Wand-Höhlen, Frauenhöhle bei Semriach ...) which were inhabited by cave bears, cave lions and men from 40.000 – 50.000 BP.

# How to get there?

Airport Vienna-Schwechat or Airport Graz For further transport by train see below:

• FROM AIRPORT WIEN SCHWECHAT

There are busses that directly depart from the airport to the train mainstation Wien Meidling.

The ride lasts approximately half an hour (between 6:00 and 24:00 there is a bus every 30 min.) Bus ticket is 7€ (you can buy it in the bus).

Leave the bus at station "Wien Dörfelstraße" ( = Meidling Bahnhof), there are trains that depart regularly for Graz HBf.

We will provide shuttle service from airport Graz and main train station Graz

• FROM TRAIN STATION WIEN MEIDLING

Since autumn 2009 the train station "Wien Meidling" is the central station for arrival and departure to and from Vienna. There are trains that depart regularly for Graz HBf every hour (not at night, the last train is about 21:00 pm, check the schedule!). Price from Vienna to Graz approx. 34€ (regular ticket).

 Drachenhöhle/Mixnitz: 1 1/5 – 2 h 1,5 - 2 hours walk to the cave entrance, 500m altitude difference, mountainous terrain, physical fitness and appropriate equipment are necessary: hiking shoes, rain shield, warm clothing, backpack, headlamp (optional)

Lunch: Picknick at the cave entrance, packed lunch will be provided
